

Statement on behalf of the PTFC Trust

As custodians of the shares in Partick Thistle Football Club, our sole mission is to ensure the club we all love is passed safely from one generation to the next.

We will not waiver from this objective, and believe it is best achieved by having the fans, the Club and the Trust working in harmony. This is not the case at present, we see it as our duty to bring the parties closer together.

We are currently arranging to meet with all fan groups including The Jags Foundation to understand their views on fan ownership, the current board of directors and the appropriate vehicle to own the shares in the club.

We are meeting with the club board next week, and are keen to appraise the skills each director brings to the club. Should the board require to be strengthened, we will not hesitate to make a change.

It is also our intention to add 2 new directors to the board as soon as is practicable, until the end of the season. One will be a representative of the Trust, with the other selected by supporters.

We would also invite nominations from fans who wish to be co-opted onto the PTFC Trust Board until elections are held at the end of the season. This will be a separate appointment.

We would urge supporters and fan groups to nominate individuals they would like to put forward for consideration for these positions. All nominations should be sent to contact@ptfctrust.com

We will shortly be inviting supporters to volunteer for a working party to shape the future constitution of the Trust Deed.

It is the intention of all the current Trustees to resign their positions when we are satisfied that the shares in the club are held by appropriately qualified people, in a suitable fan ownership vehicle.

This will inevitably take time and mean changes, so we would ask for your patience and assistance while we are on this journey.

It's time for everyone who loves Partick Thistle to unite and pull in the same direction, starting on Saturday against Cove Rangers.
